Please remember that our sports day this year will be held in the Mary Peter's Track on Friday 24 May.

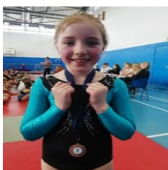
P1-P3 will finish school at 11:45 a.m. P4-P7 at 12:00noon.
