SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

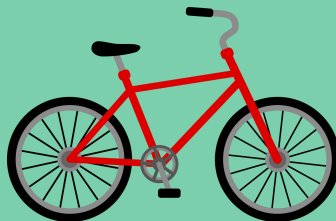
8.30am - Bike Breakfast for all pupils who cycle to school on the day. Come along for a brioche and a free gift!
