The only exception is that we will still be running a parent information evening for Primary 1.

To replace parent information evenings, we will be running a series of parent workshops. Some of these will also be delivered by outside agencies. Our first two sessions will take place after the Primary 1 parent information evening on Thursday 12 September. Details are below.

SESSION 1 5.00PM
