## School Photographs - Wednesday 31 - Thursday 1 February

**' Tempest photography will be in school this Wednesday 31 January and Thursday 1 February. Please ensure your child is wearing a polo shirt, school sweatshirt, grey trousers, shorts or skirt, grey socks, and black school shoes on BOTH Wednesday and Thursday.**

**In P4-7, if it is a PE day, they need to wear their school uniform to school in the morning and bring trainers and tracksuit bottoms to school in a bag.**

**If your child is in P5-P7 and they are in a school sports team, they need to bring trainers and black or navy shorts or tracksuit bottoms to school BOTH days. If your child is in the P7 recorder group, school band, orchestra, or woodwind group, they need to bring their instruments BOTH days.**

**Tempest will be taking a class photograph, individual photographs of each child, and family photographs of siblings. You will be able to purchase these photographs and we use the class and sports/music photographs in our school magazine which is published in June. The photographs won't be used online or on our website or social media. There isn't a permission slip for this event. However, if you would like your child to opt out from the school photographs, please let your child's teacher know today. Finally, if your child is absent on the day of the photographs, it won't be possible to retake the photographs.'**
