Nicole was awarded a certificate for Ice Skating, Proficiency in Grade 5. Well done!



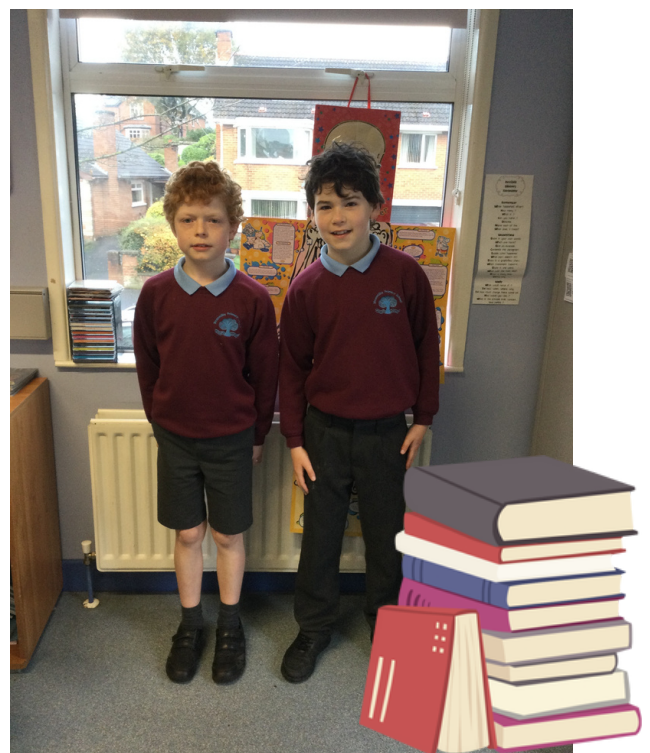
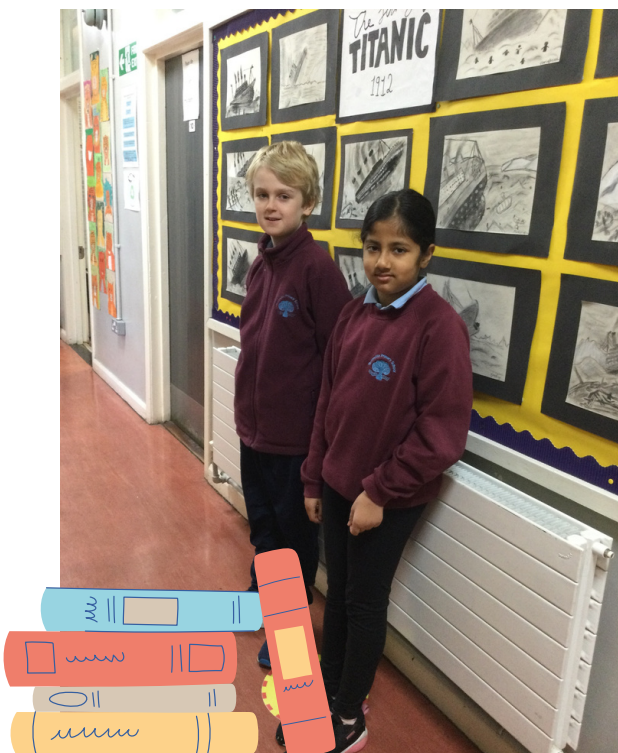
AR Millionaires!
