**We need your help**

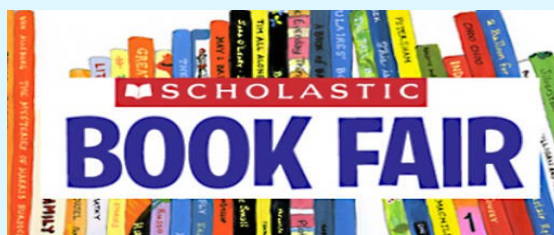
